## First Release of U.S. Census 2020 Data

On August 12, 2021, the U.S. Census Bureau released the first Census 2020 results to the public through the release of redistricting data (a.k.a. Public Law 94-171 data).

The Livingston County Planning Department has processed the data for all 20 Livingston County communities (County, Township, City and Village geography) in easy to read tables with an accompanying trend analysis provided for each table. The tables can be found on the County Planning website at:

## TREND:

During the 2010 - 2020 decade Livingston County's population growth has slowed compared to previous decades, with a percent growth of 7.1% compared to a 15.3% growth in the previous 2000 -2010 decade.

## **New Deadline for Livingston County Amendments**

The Livingston County Planning Department is changing its deadline for the receipt of Zoning, Master Plan and P.A. 116 Farmland Amendments. No longer will the deadline date be on a Friday. The deadline will now be two (2) weeks in advance of a Livingston County Planning Commission meeting. This time frame will allow County Planning Staff a minimum of one week to review amendment cases (instead of the current minimum 5 day period) before mailing them to Livingston County Planning Commissioners. For your convenience, the deadline dates for the remaining 2021 months will be as follows:
